Medication

Medicines will be collected on arrival. Exceptions are made for asthma inhalers.

Please bring to camp:

- Sleeping bag, pillow and roll mat (airbeds only if attending Youth camp)
- Pyjamas
- Summer clothing including underwear!
- Warmer clothing - jumpers/trousers
- Swimming costume and bath size towel
- Toiletries including hairbrush, shampoo/conditioner, toothbrush and toothpaste
- Suntan cream & sunhat
- Waterproof coat/jacket
- Wellies or walking boots
- Torch and spare batteries
- Trainers
- Water Bottle
- Spending Money (no more than £25)
- Purse or wallet
- Small backpack for trips
- Plastic bag for wet swimming clothes

Space in tents is limited. So a smaller case and sleeping bags etc in bin bags is a better option than a huge case with sleeping bag and pillow in case
